# THE CITY OF EVERETT PUBLIC WORKS "LET IT RAIN" Rain Barrel Program

Rain barrels collect water from rooftops to help control stormwater runoff and pollution. Water flows into the barrel from your downspout and is stored for future use.

## Make a Rain Barrel

Attend a "Make it, Take it" workshop and build your own rain barrel. Public Works will supply the barrels, parts and tools. You build your functional rain barrel at the workshop. The fee covers the price of the 55-gallon barrel and parts.
